If You Choose to Break a Rule

You will receive a behavior report and a consequence corresponding to the level of the behavior. (See the behavior chart for Level I-IV behaviors and their possible consequences. The behavior chart can be found in the parent handbook, the middle school notebook, and posted in each classroom.)

Severe behavior - Send to principal

Behavior reports can be given to a student by any staff member in any class, at any time on campus, or at any school activity. If a student receives a behavior report, he or she must sign it as well as take it home to be signed by a parent. The behavior report must be returned the next day. A duplicate copy of the behavior report will be sent home in the Lancer Folder for parents to keep.
